

## Roaming Access

Access to Wiley Online Library is IP (Internet Protocol) range access controlled: This means that no login is required for accessing subscribed content from within your organisation's network. However if you wish to access subscribed content from home or on the road, you can activate roaming access.

To set up roaming access you must be a [registered user](#), logged in and within your institution IP

(network) range to activate.

1. Login and go to My Profile.


2. Click on the Roaming Access link on the left menu.

3. To activate or refresh roaming access click on this link.

Roaming access is limited to 3 months.

4. The expiry date of your current roaming access period is shown here.

To refresh, simply click the Refresh Roaming Access link again.
